The University	The Koblenz University of Applied Sciences ("Hochschule Koblenz") is located on the beautiful river Rhine, halfway between the cities Cologne and Mainz. The UNESCO World Heritage "Mittelrhein" (Middle Rhine) is one of the warmest and driest regions of central Europe and attracts millions of visitors from all over the world every year. The Koblenz University of Applied Sciences was founded in 1996 and today around 9000 students from five faculties attend the growing University. The city of Koblenz has a lot to offer. Besides numerous bars and restaurants in the historic old town, the many surrounding castles at the Rhine and Mosel also are worth a visit. For more athletic activities are the trails along the rivers a great opportunity for hiking or bike tours.

Fees	There are no tuition fees, only a semester contribution of approx. 280 € for the whole
	semester, including the enrollment and the semester ticket for public transport.
Academic year	Summer semester: From mid of March until mid of July (exam period included)
	Winter semester: From mid of September until end of January (exam period included)
Exam period	Last three weeks after lecture period.
Study review	Usually written exams at the end of a course, but presentations or projects during the
	semester are also possible, depending on the course description.
Orientation period	Before the official beginning of each semester, the International Office offers an
	orientation week for all exchange students. During this week, you will enroll at the
	University and the International Office will support you to fulfill all the necessary
	requirements (e.g. register with public authorities, open a bank account etc.). In
	addition, you will meet your faculty coordinator to put together a class schedule or
	adjust your Learning Agreement. Furthermore, the International Office will organize a
	German crash course, social activities, and your student mentor will show you the
	campus and city.

Deadlines	The application deadlines for the exchange program are December 15 for the following summer semester and July 15 for the following winter semester.
German Courses	For the orientation week, the International Office organizes a German A1/A2 and
	B1/B2 crash course for international students. There is also offered a German course
	for Incomings once a week during the semester with different levels (A1-C2).

Accommodation	Student dormitories: around 270€ - 370€, depending on the size and type of the room.
	Private house market: around 300€ - 500€ per month for a shared apartment. Prices
	for single apartments are between 500-700€. Please note, that finding private
	accommodation is very difficult in Koblenz and we highly advice to apply for the
	offered student dormitories.

	per year.

Liability and health	Upon arrival in Koblenz, you must purchase health insurance. The German health
insurance	insurance companies offer students an insurance rate of about 80€ per month. The
	insurance covers all costs for basic check-ups, medical treatments, and
	hospitalizations. It also covers most of the costs for prescribed medication. Liability
	insurance costs about 7€ a month and we highly recommend having it.
