OVERVIEW

By this proposal I would like to apply to receive a refund of 250 euros for a short term intensive language course in German. The course lasts 1 month (4 weeks), 80h, costs 300 Euros and it is in Bonn at Sprachschule Treffpunkt Sprachen.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. To increase my basic German knowledge from A1 level to A2 level in one month;
- 2. Combine 4 hours intensive German course with self-study efforts of mine;
- 3. With help of the internet to practice the listening and reading skills;
- 4. At the end of this course to communicate basically in German language and interact in a culturally appropriate manner with native speakers of this language;

SPECIFICATIONS

Course: Short term intensive course A2/B1 at Spracenschule Treffpunkt Sprachen (Adelheidisstr. 80, 53222 Bonn) starting on 6th August 2020, in the mornings from 9 am to 1 pm.

Home study: Duration 2,5h, which is: 20 min Read online article or news; 20 min listening podcasts in <u>https://www.germanpod101.com/index.php</u>; 20 min watching grammar classes on YouTube (Easy German channel); 20 min break; 30 min watching an episode of tv-show in German (Dark tv-series); 20 min exercising at language app (Duolingo); 10 min writing what I have learned at that day.

Extra: Do the home assignments, and repeat what you learn new in the course

SMART: Main Goal – Improve from A1 to A2 level within a month.

Specific: To participate in a short term intensive language course in German level A2/B1 at Sprachschule Treffpunkt Sprachen and at the end of the course have a vocabulary of 2000 words that will help to hold a basic conversation with my local friends.

Measurable: Each day I will spend 2,5hours for self-study and for 4 days of every week 4hours in the course.

Achievable: Being physically in Germany and having a German surrounding will provide me with more advantages and knowledge regarding the new language.

Relevant: For my long term plan, learning German will help me to do my master's degree in Germany and also to apply for a job or internship.

Time-bound: The intensive course will start on 6th August 2020 ending on 3rd September 2020. It has a total of 80h and will be held in the mornings starting from 9 am until 1 pm.
